- **Copy of your passport information page**
- Transcripts of the last school you attended The transcripts must be in English. They can be from your high school or university.
- Payment of the \$150 application fee Pay online via Flywire at www.flywire.com/pay/mercereliapplication.
- Bank statement (if applying for an F-1 student visa)
- The official bank statement (with English translation) must indicate that you, or your sponsor, have a specific amount of money to support you during your studies at Mercer. You can find the specific amount required on the "How to Apply" section of our website.
