

Meanwhile, accounting students use the latest industry-standard software in the Joseph L. Peterson '87 Accounting Lab. There's even a course to help you build your own career plan.

Because business is global, so is everything in the curriculum. Each course deals with international issues and case studies. Most of the international students on campus are part of the School of Business and Economics, so you can't help but get a global perspective here. And through our study-abroad program, you can get an up-close look at business in China, England, Mexico, Australia, and elsewhere.

Hands-on experience will even come from the classroom, especially with a new \$14 million academic building, slated to open in spring 2013. The state-of-the-art building will house video conferencing rooms, an accounting lab and a trading room with a stock-market ticker. The new building will enhance the resources, classrooms, laboratories and office space, ensuring an education of the highest quality to students.

Then there are the business clubs: they not only talk business but engage in it. Club members have conducted marketing surveys, run stock market simulations, held fun workshops in business etiquette, and even run consumer tests for dog biscuits. So when they graduate, they've got a firm hold on business in the real world.

One faculty member has written 26 books on hedge funds and managed futures. Another is a SUNY distinguished service professor. Several have won SUNY Chancellor's Awards for Excellence.
