>> LEARN WHAT INTRIGUES YOU

Maybe your interests span several subjects: history and psychology, or criminal justice and political science. At SUNY Plattsburgh, you can customize your program as you see fit. Pursue a double major, declare a minor, or craft a program of study entirely your own. Moreover, every social science major overlaps with every other — so you can see issues like immigration from many angles.

History students learn to discover and create their own interpretations of the past. Psychology students learn the nuances of research. Everyone hones the ability to read, write, analyze, and think: exactly the skills that employers seek in any job candidate.

>> DO WHAT YOU LEARN

Imagine interning at the Supreme Court or the State Department, conducting original research in sociology or anthropology, lobbying in support of women's issues, or taking part in distinguished national honor societies. You can do all this at SUNY Plattsburgh — and much more. Join an archaeology project. Attend the Model General Assembly of the Organization of American States. Complete an internship in Québec as part of our Canadian studies minor. Take part in internships through the college's Alzheimer's Disease Assistance Center, Traumatic Brain Injury Center or the Neuropsychology Clinic. Or explore new terrain in other fields. One of our students studied gender and Jell-O advertising. Another explored the transfer of illegal goods on Lake Champlain. Name an option. It's here for you.

>> STUDY WITH EXPERTS

The faculty includes authorities on intriguing subjects, from the death penalty to peasant studies. One has appeared on national and regional media during election season. Another has written a seminal book on the environmental history of colonial Virginia. They have published articles on police ethics, urban gangs, safe sex, brain function and more.

But they don't *just* conduct research. Our professors bring their studies right into our small classrooms, with plenty of opportunity for personal attention. Even better, you can take part in their research — maybe even present at national conferences.

>> GO ANYWHERE FROM HERE

One alumnus is a security manager for the CIA. Others work for Border Patrol and the U.S. Customs Service. Many of our political science graduates have successfully translated their degree into a career in law—thanks in part to our active pre-law advisement on campus. Our psychology and sociology alumni have gone on to careers in crisis centers and at advocacy organizations for underserved communities. Others become authors and journalists, educators and activists, corporate presidents and financial experts.

Talk about practical degrees. SUNY Plattsburgh's social science programs can take you anywhere.

WHAT SETS US APART:

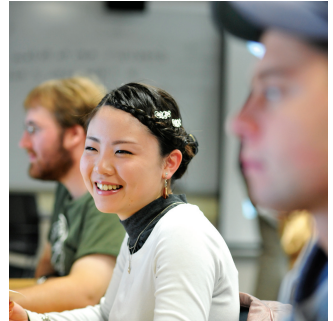
