

# **UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- Completed application
- \$55 application fee
- Academic transcript
- Recommendation letter
- One or more standardized test scores (SAT, ACT, TOEFL or IELTS)
- Minimum 79 TOEFL iBT or 6.0 IELTS for direct admission
  - Some schools/colleges require higher language test scores.
  - Transfer students may be exempt from standardized tests depending on their academic record.

# **CONDITIONAL ADMISSION**

- Available for students who are academically qualified for admission but do not meet the minimum English language requirement.
- Language test scores are not required.

If you are academically qualified and meet all admission requirements except for language, you are eligible for our Conditional Admission Program. Based on your language score, you will be placed in one of three levels of Conditional Admission.


